

Retail Sale Pricing

If you have loaded your **retail price** for products onto Windowizard when you select a product that will be the price it finds first and will be the price it uses for this product.

E.g. If you buy fabric in bulk and want to sell it at a special price (it could be higher or lower) you would enter this in so it over rides the RRP and cost plus prices.

If you haven't entered a retail price into Windowizard it will then keep searching for an **RRP price**. If there is an RRP price it will use this price for the product instead.

If you haven't entered your own retail pricing into Windowizard AND there is no RRP price, it will then keep searching for a **third option** and use the next price it can find.

Look at it as if it searches through a list of priorities.

If priority one is not there it will then find priority two, if priority two isn't there it will then go to find priority 3 and so on..

***Make sure you always have a cost plus 100%** (This is so that the price always bounces back and the product cannot be sold for 'nothing')*

Make sure there is also a cost plus 100%
